








BURNABY'S NEW GUIDING STAR



kwasən Village is a new guiding star for future generations of artists, innovators and families of all sizes. Grounded in Indigenous values and made possible through a partnership between Aquilini Development and the Musqueam and Tsleil-Waututh Nations, this culturally rich, master-planned community offers families, professionals, first-time homebuyers and empty-nesters alike a new concept of homeownership in the heart of Burnaby.

















5 INTEGRATED DISTRICTS

VALLEY DISTRICT - PREVIEWING

A district that oversees it all: Take in soaring views of the Fraser Valley to the east, looking past residential neighborhoods, the picturesque BCIT campus and Simon Fraser University, the rolling hills of the Fraser Valley, and pockets of cityscapes all the way to Mount Baker and beyond. Valley District also features the first of many culinary retailers including a specialty grocer.

MARKET DISTRICT

At the northeast corner of the project, at Canada Way and Willingdon Avenue, Market District is the community's main commercial hub and encompasses over 80,000 sq.ft. of shops and eateries as well as a welcoming gateway.

PARK DISTRICT

This central park district encompasses Daylit Creek, a restored natural ecosystem, and is kwasen Village's cultural hub with an amphitheatre, green spaces, outdoor daycare area, lounge seating, a native species garden, outdoor gathering space, picnic tables, Legends Park and Landing Park.

DIGITAL DISTRICT

Situated in the southwest corner of kwasen Village, the Digital District is home to a cutting-edge film studio poised to become the 'Hollywood of the North.' With state-of-the-art facilities and a vibrant atmosphere, the Digital District is set to inspire the next generation of filmmakers and storytellers, driving the future of filmmaking in the region.

MOUNTAIN DISTRICT










YOUR WEEKEND PLANS JUST GOT FILLED UP







Today, through partnerships with businesses, governments and neighbouring First Nations, Musqueam has been established as business leaders in the region.

səlilwətał (Tsleil-Waututh Nation) now runs multiple successful businesses, which generate their own source revenues, build capacity for economic growth, provide employment opportunities for their people, and create wealth for current and future generations. Tsleil-Waututh Nation have partnered with the Squamish and Musqueam Nations to acquire six properties in their nations' traditional territories – through the MST Corporation – which will lead to sustainable, profitable developments over the long term.
